Beginners' Guide to School Library Organisation, (2001) by Rose Damon, Education Library and Information Services of the Western Cape Education Department. Distributed by <u>EDUMEDIA (WCED)</u>. This 40 page title can be purchased very cheaply from Edumediaat a cost is R10-00 per booklet. The booklet is intended for teachers who have no library training. A *Simplified list of subject headings for school libraries* is also available.

<u>Guide to setting up an open library in primary schools.</u> Usha Mukunda (2011). Simple but worthwhile 10 page pdf on making the library a vibrant place with community interaction; ideas for activities and displays. Great ideas for developing nations as well as those with established school libraries.

<u>Hands across the Sea Library Manual for Primary Schools: Seven</u> <u>steps to creating an outstanding school library</u> by Ina Howe.

A 25 page coloured pdf file with ideas for choosing a library team, choosing and preparing a library space, getting the books ready and setting up a system for checking them out, library operations and preparing students, staff and parents.
