Visitors to Malaysia must be in possession of a valid passport or travel document with a minimum validity of six months beyond the intended visiting period. While nationals of many countries do not require visas to enter Malaysia, other may require visas. Please check with your travel agent or the nearest Malaysian Consulate or representative office before confirming your trip.
